Applications are invited from eligible candidates for filling-up 20** vacant positions of Guest Faculty for a fixed duration as prescribed by University of Delhi.

Essential Educational Qualifications:-

The qualifications for Guest Faculty will be the same as those prescribed for Assistant Professor of the University as per UGC's Regulations, i.e.

1. Good academic record as defined by the University with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in a relevant subject (Chemistry) from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University.
2. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET), conducted by UGC or CSIR*

Emoluments:

The Guest Faculty will be paid an honorarium of Rs. 1500/- per lecture, subject to a maximum of Rs. 50,000/- per month as per the UGC norms (Ref. No. F.25-1/2018(PS/MISC.) dated 28.1.2019)

How to apply:-

- (i) Online applications may be filled up using the link <https://forms.gle/c1xjXeSMEoKULqhv5>
- (ii) A short CV with the applicant's passport-sized photograph affixed on it, containing detailed qualifications, experience and published papers, with a signed declaration should be uploaded along with the filled up form.
- (iii) All uploaded documents should be self-attested.

Last date of receiving applications:-

The applications should reach the Department latest by Monday, the 11th October 2021, 10:00 AM.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

1. The applications will be screened. Only short-listed candidates will only be called for interview. The selection will be based on the performance in Interview + Academic career.
2. Selection of the candidates shall be provisional and approval of appointment will be given by the University of Delhi, subject to verification of the antecedents and documents submitted by the candidate.
3. Candidates are advised to visit the University website regularly at www.du.ac.in and www.chemistry.du.ac.in to know the date and time of interview or latest information.
4. Preferably, the interview may be carried out in regular mode.
5. The Department of Chemistry reserves the right to withdraw any advertised post(s) at any time without assigning any reason. Any consequential vacancies arising due to not joining of duties by any of the selected candidates or on resignation may also be filled up from the panel of available candidates in the Waiting List.

6. In case of any inadvertent mistake in the process of selection, which may be detected at any stage even after the issue of the appointment letter, the Department of Chemistry/ University of Delhi reserve the right to modify/withdraw/cancel any communication made to the candidate.
7. No TA/DA will be paid by the Department for attending the interview.

GENERAL NOTE:

- (i) The candidates who have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards & Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations-2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET for appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in University/Colleges/Institutes. Provided further, the award of degree to candidates registered for the M.Phil/Ph.D. programme prior to 11th July-2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree and the Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutes, subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:-
 - (a) Ph.D. Degree of the candidate awarded in regular mode only;
 - (b) Evaluation of the Ph.D. thesis by at least two external examiners;
 - (c) Open Ph.D. viva-voce of the candidate had been conducted;
 - (d) Candidate has published two research papers from/based on his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one must be in a refereed journal;
 - (e) Candidate has made at least two presentations in conference/seminars, based on his/her Ph.D. work.Such candidates must upload the NET Exemption certificate signed by a competent authority in place of the NET certificate.
- (ii) A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the Graduate and Masters Level for the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes/Differently-abled (Physically and Visually differently-abled) / Other Backward Classes (OBC – Non-Creamy Layer) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic records during direct recruitment to faculty positions. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedures.
- (iii) A relaxation of 5% may be provided, from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D. Degree-holders, who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19th September-1991.
- (iv) Relevant grade, which is regarded as equivalent of 55% wherever the grading system is followed by a recognized University, shall also be considered eligible.
