

'YUM EKO RAJ ENDOWMENT SCHOLARSHIP' UG

1. There shall be a scholarship called 'Yumeko Raj Endowment Scholarship' of the value of Rs.200/- per mensem payable out of the interest on the funds endowed by Shri Hans Raj, Yamadacho 2-4-8 Nadabu(657) Japan for helping meritorious and needy women students for pursuing M.B.B.,S. Course in the University College of Medical Sciences.
2. The scholarship shall be open to women students who have passed the Senior School Certificate Examination of the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi, or an examination recognised as equivalent thereto preferably in the first class.
3. The scholarship shall be awarded on the basis of marks-cum-means basis to needy students whose parent's income including her own income does not exceed Rs.25,000/- per annum excluding permissible standard deductions. The Selection Committee would be free to raise this limit needs to be raised upwards.
4. Preference will be given to fatherless students.
5. One out of every four scholarships awarded under this scheme will be given to a scheduled caste student, if available. If no student of this category is available, the scholarship will be given to students of general category.
6. The scholarship shall be tenable for the duration of the M.B.B.,S. course but shall be renewed after every year on the basis of satisfactory performance of the awardee.
7. No student shall be eligible for the award of the scholarship if she already holds a scholarship awarded by the Delhi University or any other University or the State Government or a private body other than a freeship. In case a student who has been awarded this scholarship accepts any other scholarship/financial assistance from any other source, she shall be required to refund the amount received by her on this account.
8. If it should appear at any time during the tenure of the scholarship that the scholar has failed to make satisfactory progress or has been found guilty of gross misconduct or has been irregular in attendance, she shall, after due warning, in writing, be reported by the Principal of the College to the Academic Council, which may withdraw the scholarship.
9. The scholarship shall be awarded by the Academic Council on the recommendation of the Selection Committee constituted as follows:-
  - i) The Dean, Faculty of Medical Sciences,
  - ii) The Principal, University College of Medical Sciences,
  - iii) One other Professor in the College nominated by the Vice-Chancellor,
  - iv) Dr.(Mrs) C.S. Chuttani, presently Professor of Preventive and Social Medicine(donor's nominee during her life time only).
10. Applications for the award of the scholarship obtainable from the office of the Registrar, (Scholarship Cell) should reach the Registrar, University of Delhi, Delhi-110007, through the Principal of the University College of Medical Sciences by the date mentioned in the notification issued by the Registrar in this behalf.
11. The payment of the scholarship amount shall be made to the student concerned through the Principal, University College of Medical Sciences, on presentation of a bill and a certificate to the effect that the scholar was not in receipt of any other scholarship/financial assistance from any other source.
12. The scholars who have been awarded this scholarship may at their discretion, return the amount of the award made to them after they have completed the course and secure jobs and are in a position to return the money. The amount so returned by the students may be added to the Endowment Fund. The unutilised amount in any year shall be added to the corpus of the endowment fund.
