"THE XVI ALL INDIA UNIVERSITY TAMIL TEACHERS' CONFERENCE  
SCHOLARSHIP!

1. There shall be a scholarship known as 'The XVI All India University Tamil Teachers' Conference Scholarship of the value of Rs. 150/- p.m. to be awarded out of the annual income accruing from the endowment fund of Rs. 16,700/- received from Dr. Sallai Ilanthiraiyan Chairman and Mr. P. Balasubramanian, Convenor of the XVI All India University Tamil Teachers' Conference Committee, 9A/5, W.E.A., Karol Bagh, New Delhi-110005.
2. The Scholarship shall be awarded in alternate years to a student admitted to M.A. Course in Tamil in the Department of Modern Indian Languages of the University, who has secured the highest percentage of marks in Tamil in the qualifying degree examination.
3. The Scholarship shall be tenable for a period of two years renewable for the second year on the basis of satisfactory performance of the awardee at studies and examination during 1st year.
4. a. No student shall be eligible for the award of this scholarship if he/she already holds a scholarship awarded by the Delhi University or any other University or the Central Government, or any State Government or Private Body, other than freeship.  
b. In case any scholar accepts any other scholarship/financial assistance from any other source, he/she shall be required to refund the amount received by him on this account from the date he/she accepts the other scholarship/financial assistance.
5. If it should appear at any time during the tenure of the award that the scholar has failed to make satisfactory progress or has been found guilty of gross misconduct or has been irregular in attendance, he/she shall, after due warning, in writing, be reported by the Principal/Head of the Institution/Department to the Academic Council which may reduce suspend or withdraw the scholarship.
6. The Scholarship shall be awarded by the Academic Council on the recommendations of a Selection Committee constituted as follows:-
  1. Dean, Faculty of Arts
  2. Head, Department of M.I.L.
  3. One of the Professor in Tamil in the Department to be nominated by Head of the Department of Modern Indian Language.

7. Application for the Scholarship, in the prescribed form obtainable from the office of the Registrar, (Scholarship Cell) should reach the Registrar, Delhi University, Delhi-110007, through the Head of the Department/Institution concerned by the date mentioned in the notification issued by the Registrar in this behalf.
8. The payment of the Scholarship amount shall be made to the scholar through the Head of the Institution/Department from May each year on presentation of a bill, a certificate to the effect that during the period covered in the bill, the scholar was not in receipt of any other scholarship/financial assistance from any other source.
9. The Unutilized amount in any year shall be added to the corpus of the endowment fund.
